Creedence Clearwater Revival

INTRO:

Walking Riff starts with percussion only on **C - G - C 2x**

Walking Riff continues with band in on: **F - C - C-G-C**

Key: C
tempo: 108

C **G** **C**
Early in the evenin' just about supper time
Over by the courthouse they're starting to unwind
F **C**
Four kids on the corner trying to bring you up
C **G** **C**
Willy picks a tune out and he blows it on the harp

CHORUS:

F **C** **G** **C**
Down on the corner, out in the street
 F **C** **G** **C**
Willy and the Poorboys are playin' / Bring a nickel; tap your feet

Rooster hits the washboard and people just got to smile
Blinky thumps the gut bass and solos for a while
Poorboy twangs the rhythm out on his kalamazoo
Willy goes into a dance and doubles on kazoo

CHORUS

SOLO
(walking riff: full verse prog)

CHORUS

INSTRUMENTAL C-G-C 2x

You don't need a penny just to hang around
But if you've got a nickel, won't you lay your money down?
Over on the corner there's a happy noise
People come from all around to watch the magic boy

CHORUS 3X
End on last beat of last bar of Chorus, with requisite rhythm (the strums after "...stamp your feet.")
